

1. BLUEBIRD GARAGE: 39 ALBERTYN ROAD

Exhibition space showcasing both a Fine Art and Design Exhibition. Expect a selection of locally designed jewellery, clothing, furniture and other goods. Food stalls and a craft bar will also be operational. Jungle gym and kids area.

2. SUE BEATTIE/ MOSAIC MUIZENBERG: 31 ALBERTYN RD

An exhibition of paintings and mosaics by Sue Beattie and mosaics by Aletta du Toi.

3. LESLEY CORNWELL AND FRIENDS: 2 WHERRY ROAD

Exhibition of the work of Lesley Cornwell, Gelda Walsh and friends; showing hand painted children's clothing, paintings, jewellery and more...

4. BLUE PLANET: 25 MAIN RD

Artist duo Koos de Wet and Anastasia Sarantinou are providing a perfect space for art lovers. This space is created for the making and sales of their own art and it is a place of teaching and learning fine art for adults and kids.

5. PATRICIA DE VILLIERS AND FRIENDS: 11 RHODESIA ROAD

An exhibition of illustrations, drawings, prints and ceramics in earthenware, stoneware and porcelain by Patricia de Villiers, Eve Sandler and Joan Shaer.

6. ZOE MAFHAM/ FLICK INC: 16 HOLLAND ROAD

Zoe Mafham is exhibiting art made from found paper, including magazines, children's books and maps, reformed into portraits, streetscapes and design pieces.

Flick Inc is a creative studio, maker of flickglass, fused glass jewellery and My China Ceramics, a fun illustrated ceramic range.

7. STUDIO MUSE: 35 ALEXANDER RD

Mirjam Macleod is an artist and Therapeutic Art Facilitator. She works with children, adolescents and adults and teaches from her sunny studio.

8. ANGELA MAXWELL-HOUGH/LARS FISCHEDICK: 10 PALMER ROAD

Angela Hough-Maxwell is a psychologist, artist, art process facilitator, yoga teacher. Her art explores inner process, consciousness, becoming and being a mother.

Lars Fischedick is an artist, architect, draftsman, model builder, philosopher. His art explores perspectives and vanishing points, and points of synchronistic meeting. Burning, acrylic paint and wood.

9. CHARLOTTE CORBETT: 22 PALMER ROAD

This open studio will show paintings and painted ceramics by Charlotte Corbett and Ruth Carneson. Ruth's work is mixed media and playful; sometimes she uses it to process difficult subject matter.

10. KITCH KOMBUIJS: PALMER ROAD.

Natasha Norman will be exhibiting her Gyotaku fish prints. These unique images are printed from actual fish caught in the False Bay harbour by local fishermen. The technique of printing fish is something she learnt on a recent art residency in Japan.

11. MUIZENBERG POSTCARD PROJECT: 29 Palmer Rd

A window installation showcasing the Muizenberg Postcard Project. Postcards are available to purchase at the Made in Muizenberg shop.

12. MADE IN MUIZENBERG: 36 PALMER ROAD

The Made in Muizenberg + CoOp hosts, supports and celebrates local micro enterprises of quality made design and products

13. GINA NIEDERHUMER: 38 PALMER ROAD

In Gina Niederhumer's Studio, you can find a variety of hand-dyed yarn, hand knitted socks and beanie's in her own nordic designs, fibre art, stationaries, stitched jewellery, handmade toys and travel inspired works... not to forget her Gingerbread men and sharks. The studio supports various outreach groups and showcases the work of ca 35 local stitchers and makers. The idea behind the shop is to support local, handmade and sustainable works by individual artists and fine crafters.

14. M&M GALLERIES: SHOP 3, 31 PALMER ROAD

M&M Galleries is a crafting art gallery that design, craft, exhibit and sell uniquely and custom designed high quality African paintings and works of art. Our mission is to bring together talented contemporary artists showing and selling their great artworks. These are from works of both recognized artists and upcoming artist aiming to make it in the world of art. The galleries range of products include a variety of themes like African traditional crafts, prints, photo, jewellery, sculpture, ceramic, textiles and original oil on canvas paintings.

15. SKERMUNKIL: 44 PALMER ROAD

Skermunkil design studio specializes in Jewellery design and manufacture. They make a range of jewellery, working in various mediums including silver, brass, enamels, porcelain and found objects. They also produce a small range of porcelain products for the home including cups, bowls and planters.

16. ANNAPATAT FABRICS AND FURNISHINGS: 11 ATLANTIC RD
